From the Pastor's Heart . . .

Help me! Where is time going? It seems like just yesterday we started a new church year and here it is again—a new church year. The older I get the smarter my Mom gets. As a child, I would wish for Christmas or birthday or some other special occasion to get here sooner. She would often respond, "don't wish your life away...the older you get the faster time seems to go by." I suppose this is what she meant.
